# **BIKE BARN**

# REFRIGERATOR SERVICES

Refrigerator Services provides a one-year rental service of mini-fridges to students who live on campus. Renting a fridge for one year of on-campus housing is cheaper than buying a mini-fridge, ensuring students are saving money where they can.



# THE PANTRY

The Pantry is an ASUCD unit that fights food insecurity on campus by providing non-perishable, high-protein foods to students free of charge. All students need is a valid UC Davis ID card to claim up to three meals a day. Thanks to a generous donation from Chancellor Gary May, the Pantry was upgraded to a new facility inside the Memorial Union for greater storage space and to attract more foot traffic.





With 48 buses, 21 routes, and over 22,000 passengers daily, Unitrans provides public transportation services to the city of Davis. Undergraduate students ride for free, so keep an eye out for the iconic red buses the next time you need a ride!


























# **CREATIVE MEDIA**








# CCE


